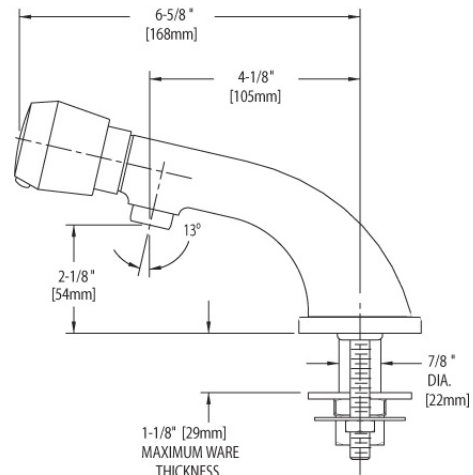
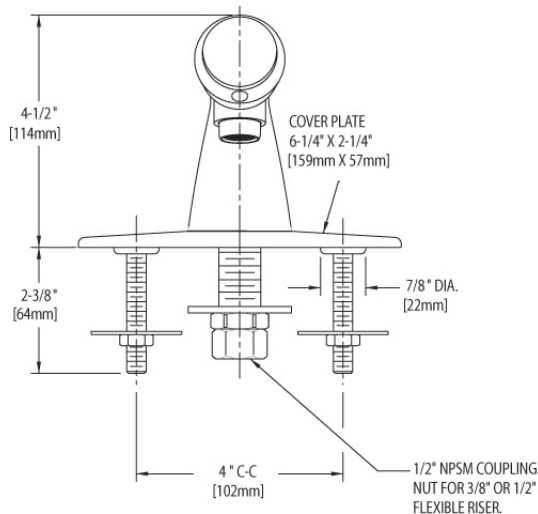

Chicago Faucets No. 857-E12-665PSHCP, polished chrome plated solid cast brass body construction with 4-1/8" integral spout and 4" C-C deck cover plate. Integral inlet shanks on 4" centers. 2.2 GPM pressure compensating aerator outlet. Tapered vandal-resistant metering handle with color coded index button. MVP™ push button, 0.25 gal/cycle self-closing metering cartridge. Inlet shanks contain standard 1/2" NPSM threaded inlets with coupling nuts for connection to 3/8" or 1/2" standard flexible risers. Mounting hardware included. This product meets ADA requirements and is tested and certified to industry standards: ASME A112.18.1, NSF 61 Sec. 9, and CSA B125.



Operation and Maintenance

Installation should be in accordance with local plumbing codes. Flush all pipes thoroughly before installation. After installation, remove spout outlet or flow control and flush faucet thoroughly to clear any debris. Care should be taken when cleaning the product. Do not use abrasive cleaners, chemicals or solvents as they can result in surface damage. Use mild soap and warm water for cleaning and protecting the life of Chicago Faucet products.
